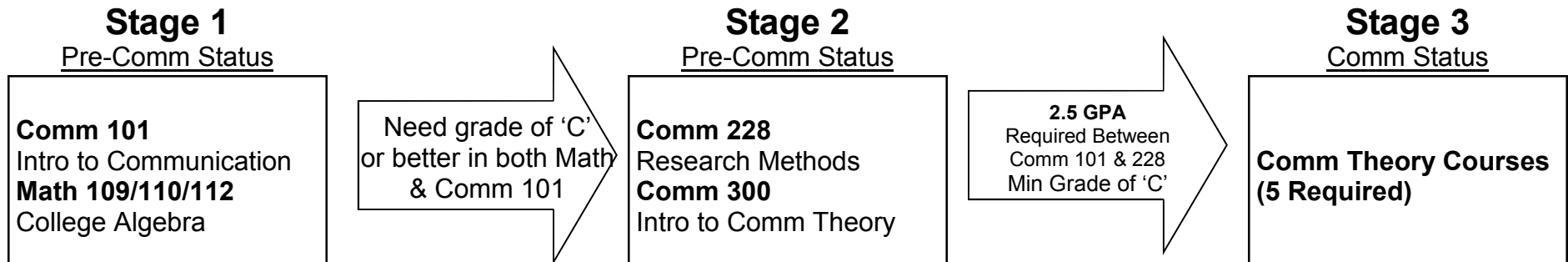

- 33 units of Communication coursework required
- 18 units must be upper division (course numbered 300-499)
- 18 units must be completed at the University of Arizona
- Students must earn a 2.0 GPA in the major to graduate
- Communication majors need to be prepared to take summer courses
- Not all courses are offered each semester
- Junior class standing is recommended for upper division coursework
- All Comm majors must complete a minor or second major
- 120 units required for graduation
- 42 units of upper division (courses numbered 300-499) required for graduation
